Request For Bids (RFB)

- Request for Bids is used for the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, and services
- The award is made to the lowest priced responsive and responsible vendor who meets the specifications
- Responses may be hand-delivered or sent by mail and must be received by the due date & time. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Can be for individual items, services, one-time purchases or annual contracts
- Discounts are taken into consideration for award.
- Results are posted at <u>www.labavn.org</u>

Request for Proposals (RFP)

- Request for Proposals are used for large projects and professional services
- The award is made to the proposer(s) with the highest score based upon the published award criteria (price is always considered but it isn't the deciding factor)

RFB vs RFP

- In order to be <u>considered</u> for award, the vendor **MUST** meet the:
 - Request for Bids Specifications
 - Request for Proposals Qualifications
- In order to be <u>selected</u> for award, the vendor **MUST** have the:
 - Request for Bids Lowest price including any discounts
 - Request for Proposals Winning score according to the selection criteria
