Unfortunately, we have become very familiar with the constant flow of jet fuel exhaust permeating through our neighborhood. The smell of this exhaust is so strong that it has greatly limited our ability to enjoy our time outdoors. We are very concerned about our health and that of our neighbors, and can provide research articles detailing the health risks associated with this chronic exposure. We ask that the aircraft alongside Hayvenhurst between Saticoy St and Sherman Way, not be allowed to idle for longer than absolutely necessary to get on to a runway or other area away from residential properties. We also are requesting the placement of an air quality and particulate matter meter near Hayvenhurst St and Cohasset St (near VNY airport gate/side entrance) to provide real time data regarding the jet fuel exhaust exposure to our neighborhood and the potential need for additional changes to ensure our neighborhood residents' safety.
