Building a Better VNY: Exit Taxiways Reconstruction – Phase 1 Project

In February 2025, work will commence on a \$15.4 million, 6-month project to reconstruct segments of Taxiways D, E, F, and Q. This project will deliver important upgrades and extended lifespan to the airfield facilities that contribute to VNY's world-class status. Improvements will be phased to maximize federal grant reimbursements and minimize operational impacts during construction.

Work will include reconstruction of:

- Taxiways D, E, and F from Runway 16R-34L to 16L-34R
- Taxiways E and F between Taxiway A and Runway 16R-34L
- Taxiway Q between Taxiway B and Runway 16R-34L

This project will be managed by Los Angeles World Airports' Development Group with RS&H, Inc. as the engineer of record and Griffith Company as the general contractor.

Reconstruction includes:

- Full-depth asphalt pavement section reconstruction
- Infield grading and drainage improvements
- Airfield electrical improvements
- Airfield lighting and signage
- Pavement markings
