





Super Scoopers Arrival - Two CL-415 Super Scooper fire-fighting aircraft arrived at VNY on August 6, about 3 weeks ahead of schedule, to provide assistance during the wildfire season. The aircraft are leased from Quebec by the City of Los Angeles Fire Department and are expected to remain at VNY through

September. Two Erickson Air-Crane helicopters are also at VNY to
