Formation of 99s

- ▶ The Ninety-Nine Club was formed in Long Beach, California, in 1929.
- ▶ At that time, there was a meeting in Long Beach of women pilots.
- ▶ Of the 117 original members, the group took its name from Amelia Earhart's flight.
- ▶ The Ninety-Nine Club pilots from 35 countries around the world. Our headquarters are in Oklahoma.
